ESTABLISH YOUR GOALS

ADVERTISE IN ADVANCE

ENGAGE IN SOCIAL MEDIA

USE AN INTERACTIVE DISPLAY

The best way to draw a crowd to your booth is to interact with them. Games, quizzes, contests, prizes, or scheduled demonstrations give people that extra reason to visit your booth.

ACTIVELY ENGAGE ATTENDEES

If you do send a new staff member, make sure an experienced person is there as well, so newer staff can watch and learn.
